

## **GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF YOUR PAPER TO THE SPECIAL ISSUE OF MATHEMATICAL AND COMPUTER MODELLING.**

- All papers must be submitted directly to the journal Mathematical and Computer Modelling through the EES (electronic submission system). Please, do not submit them to the Organizers of the Conference. Follow the link “Submit and article” at the webpage of the journal: <http://www.elsevier.com/locate/mcm>
- **IT IS VERY IMPORTANT that authors select SI: MME&HB 2011 when they reach the "Article Type" step in the submission process.** If you chose Regular Article your paper could not be included in the Special Issue corresponding to the Mathematical Modelling in Engineering & Human Behaviour 2011.
- The same author cannot appear in more than **ONE PAPER**.
- The maximum length of your paper must be 12 pages (Using the Elsalt style with the default font).
- Word and Latex files are accepted but Latex is preferred. Figures can be submitted in any standard format: jpeg, gif, eps, ps, etc...
